Your nominations should be made by completing the attached form and returning it to the Hon Sec

These nominations will be considered by the Regional Committee on Sunday 15th May and 3 nominations will be put forward for consideration in each category by an Awards Sub-Committee elected by the Regional Committee. Three societies will be nominated for each award and be informed of the nomination by 31st May 2016. The Awards Sub-committee will meet to look at the shows in detail and the result of their adjudication will be announced at the Awards Ceremony and AGM on Sunday 3rd July.
