NODA YOUTH AWARD CRITERIA

- 1) A Youth Award may be awarded from the age of **11** after a minimum of three years' service to a maximum age of 20 ie. the Award may first be presented at the age of 14.
- 2) The Bye-Laws made by the Council for the Long Service Awards shall apply as appropriate.
- 3) The cost of the Award shall be decided by the Directors of NODA Ltd from time to time.

NODA YOUTH CERTIFICATE CRITERIA

- 1) A Youth Certificate may be awarded from the age of **5** for every three years of service to a maximum age of 20 ie. the Certificate may first be presented at the age of 8.
- 2) The Bye-Laws made by the Council for the Long Service Awards shall apply as appropriate.
- 3) The cost of the Certificate shall be decided by the Directors of NODA Ltd from time to time.
