(One nomination per society per category) The show must have been visited by a nominated person from the SE Regional Committee who wrote a review which subsequently appeared on the NODA website.

Your nominations should be made by completing the attached form and returning it to the Regional Secretary Pauline Catterall <u>pauline.catterall@noda.org.uk</u> to be received by  $1^{st}$  May 2017. These nominations will be considered by the Regional Committee on Sunday  $14^{th}$  May and 3 nominations will be put forward for consideration in each category by an Awards Sub-Committee elected by the Regional Committee. Three societies will be nominated for each award and be informed of the nomination by  $31^{st}$  May 2017. The Awards Sub-committee will meet to look at the shows in detail and the result of their adjudication will be announced at the Awards Ceremony and AGM on Sunday  $2^{nd}$  July.

POSTER AND PROGRAMME COMPETITION 2016 deadline 31<sup>st</sup> January 2017

Many of you will be aware of the annual competition for programmes and posters. The South East, in common with all the other Noda regions, holds its own competition with the winning entries being entered into the National competition.

Last year, we received more than 74 programmes and 23 posters from 30 societies. (There are over 250 societies in the South East Region.) Those who attend the South East Regional Conference will have a chance to see them on display.

There are at least three judges, who each mark independently - their marks are averaged to give the final total. The entry with the highest mark is declared the winner. Entries are marked against a set of criteria which are used by all the national regions. After winners have been announced at the regional conference, feedback forms will be sent to all entrants, showing them the marks that they achieved and the position that they reached in the competition.

Posters should be A4 size or larger. Please remember that your poster should display the 'legal lettering' as specified by the rights holders. **Programmes** fall into one of three categories. The **deluxe** (sometimes called *souvenir*) class are those with 24 or more sides; the standard class are those with between 16 and 20 sides and the basic class are those with 12 sides or fewer.

Programmes MUST carry the Noda crest (paired with the EXACT words 'Affiliated to the National Operatic and Dramatic Society' or the logo with the current strapline 'Be inspired by amateur theatre'. Examples of these are available for download from the website together with information about NODA which you might also consider including. There are extra marks for detailed information about NODA.

If you have any other questions then please do not hesitate to ask your Regional Rep or Councillor.

We look forward to receiving your entries - deadline: 31<sup>st</sup> January 2017
