
The details of the revised rules for the Programme & Poster competition are to be found on the NODA website (<u>Programme & Poster Details</u>) together with all the versions of the new branding and inserts for your programmes.

The Regional Reps are in the process of recommending societies for their district Accolades of Excellence. Those recommendations will be put forward for consideration for Regional Awards. This year we are introducing accolades specifically for youth groups where there are 4 or more groups in a district. There is no reason why a Regional Rep cannot recommend a group for a musical, drama or pantomime



accolades. We have Regional Awards for a variety of genres including Best Drama, Best Shakespeare, Best New Show -original work only, Best Variety Show – to include compilations and concerts, Best Pantomime, plus several categories of musical productions.

The last committee meeting received a report from the Youth Coordinators which was the result of a survey that was undertaken. It highlighted a variety of things including Local Authority Licensing and cyberbullying. The information has been passed to the NODA Councillor heading up the development of a new youth strategy. In the meantime, please continue to let us know of any problems you are encountering, particularly with Local Authorities and we will try and lobby the relevant government department.
