# NEW REP FOR DISTRICT 4




Robin Kelly

He was a constant member of our front-of-house teams, selling programmes and raffle tickets and meeting and greeting audiences. He was extremely generous with his donations to the Company, especially for after-show parties and always helped with the breakdown at the end of a production run. Fred Jones was a great servant to the people of Barking and Dagenham and one of its real characters. He will be sorely missed in many areas of community life and Barking MAD has lost one of its greatest supporters.
